Next Citizen Fire Academy Class to begin February 5

St. Lucie County, FL – The St. Lucie County Fire District will be holding its next Citizen Fire Academy, starting Tuesday, February 5. The Academy is for residents who want to learn more about their Fire District and how they handle emergencies.

“This is a great opportunity to see the whole fire and emergency medical service process,” said Fire Chief Ron Parrish. “Previous students have enjoyed meeting our firefighters and learning more about their skills.”

The Fire Academy is a series of 6 sessions and is free, but registration is required. Sessions will meet weekly, starting at 5:30 p.m.

Participants will tour the Emergency Operations Center and the Treasure Coast Public Safety Complex. Sessions cover: home safety, fire prevention, tactical rescues, and hazardous materials. Demonstrations include the Airport Rescue and Firefighting truck (ARFF), Air Rescue, and more.
