

New Decals for Fire & Rescue Trucks in Honor of Car Crash Victim Fire District, Tax Collector, and Legacy remember Logan Daily

In recognition of Burn Awareness Week (February 6-12), Legacy Donor Services, Life Alliance, St. Lucie County Tax Collector's Office and the St. Lucie County Fire District are collaborating to bring attention to the need for more organ and tissue donors while honoring a local hero.

In October 2019, 30-year-old Logan Daily died in a car crash in Port St. Lucie. Logan was an organ donor. With his eye and tissue donation, 543 people were impacted; including six burn victims that received skin grafts.

This morning, Legacy and the Tax Collector's Office presented specially designed organ donor decals to the St. Lucie County Fire District at fire station 3. These decals will be placed on all of the rescue trucks throughout the county.

Logan's mother, Trina Long and his sons, Anthony (13) and Liam (9) participated by helping to place a decal on rescue 3 Also in attendance was burn survivor, Demetrius Gollett, who assisted in placing a decal on engine 3.

"Becoming an organ donor is the last heroic act an individual can do for another human being. Countless lives are saved every year through organ donation. We are proud to participate in this event along with our tax collector's office, who has worked so diligently to expand the number of organ donors in our community." – Fire Chief Nate Spera
