During the monthly Fire Board meeting, officials from Liberia will take possession of a decommissioned rescue truck donated by the St. Lucie County Fire District.

In September 2021, Fire Chief Nate Spera received a request for the donation on behalf of the Bassa County Association in the Americas, Inc., Africa, for any left-over equipment inventory, specifically a decommissioned ambulance to be donated to mobilize resources in the continued efforts to rebuild Liberia and Grand Bassa County.

## **New Engine 10 Push-In Ceremony**

The fire district will officially put new engine 10 into service following a traditional "Push-In" ceremony. The ceremony will include a wet down and blessing of the new apparatus.

The “Push-In” ceremony pays homage to firefighters in the 1800s who used horse-drawn equipment and would have to literally push the fire engine into the garage after returning from a fire. The event has since become a widely practice tradition for new fire engines.
