**NOTICE: Tier II Report March 1, 2023 (filing year 2022)
St. Lucie County Fire District – Facility Tier II Submission
Notification of Extremely Hazardous Substances (EHSs) Annual Inventory.**

Facility Owner/Operators:

The Treasure Coast Local Emergency Planning Committee (TCLEPC) is providing notice to St. Lucie County facility owner/operators that use, store, and/or manufacture Extremely Hazardous Substances (EHSs) and are subject to annual Tier II Extremely Hazardous Materials (EHSs) chemical inventory reporting on or before **March 1, 2023, (filing year 2022)**. St. Lucie County facilities that file/submit annual Tier IIs via *E-Plan* are considered to have met submission requirements for the **St. Lucie County Fire District** and will be considered compliant with the Florida Division of Emergency Management State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) (F.S. CH 27P-14 Hazardous Materials, subsection 252.88), SARA Title III Emergency Community Right-To-Know Act 1986 (EPCRA) Sections 312 and 324, and TCLEPC submission requirements provided this notice accompanies the Tier II. **This notice must be printed and present during hazardous materials compliance visits to meet with EPCRA, SERC, and TCLEPC submission requirements.** You may adjust your Tier II Management option in *E-Plan* to include an email notification to the St. Lucie Fire District and the TCLEPC when you file. The TCLEPC for Hazardous Materials provides technical assistance to first responders, chemical facilities, and local governments for State and federal compliance and serves as the Tier II regional repository for Indian River, Martin, Palm Beach, and St. Lucie counties. The TCLEPC and county emergency managers/fire departments conduct hazards analyses for those facilities filing Tier IIs with site visits conducted to verify chemical inventory on-site is represented accurately (within reasonable amounts) as reported on the facilities' Tier II, and to provide technical assistance in navigating *E-Plan* and emergency response plans.

The TCLEPC will provide an annual updated notice on behalf of the St. Lucie County Fire District to post on their website until otherwise directed. If the facility has this notice present on file, **paper copies of the facility's Tier II do not need to be forwarded to the St. Lucie Fire District.**

The St. Lucie County Fire District reserves the right to request a facility Tier II in paper format should they decide *E-Plan* is not adequate.
