

## **Hundred Club Check Presentation**

### **Two separate fundraisers raise \$4400 for the St. Lucie County Hundred Club**

**St. Lucie County** Today (September 21, 2022) at 4:00 PM, at the St. Lucie County Fire Board meeting, two checks totaling \$4400 will be presented to the St. Lucie County Hundred Club. The presentation will be held at the fire district's administrative building, located at 5160 NW Milner Drive, Port St. Lucie.

For the second consecutive year, the St. Lucie County Fire District designed 9/11 commemorative shirts to honor the lives lost on September 11, 2001. With the help of Dragonfly Graphics, an online store was set-up and with just a small upcharge of \$2-4 per shirt, and over \$2900 was raised to benefit the Hundred Club.

In another fundraiser to benefit the Hundred Club, the Fire District in collaboration with Play Treasure Coast Sports Tourism, HCA Florida, Lawnwood Hospital and Indian River State College held its first Stair Climb and 2-mile Run/Walk to commemorate 9/11. The event raised \$1500 through registration fees.

The purpose of The Hundred Club is to provide direct financial help for spouses and dependents of law enforcement officers and firefighters who have lost their lives or become disabled in the line of duty.
