St. Lucie County Fire District & Health Department Team Up to Install Child Passenger Seats.

St. Lucie County, FL – Today 96% of all car seats are installed improperly. To solve this problem the St. Lucie County Fire District along with the St. Lucie County Health Department and Kids Connected By Design have launched a new program. Twenty-two firefighters have recently gone through Child Passenger Seat Technician Training.

St. Lucie County Fire District is providing a free Child Safety Seat check on Wednesday, March 19. **Appointments are needed.** Please call 462-3501 to schedule your appointment

When scheduling your appointment, please have the following information:

- Age and weight of the child
- Make, model and year of the vehicle
- Manufacturer, name and model number of the car seat.

If you don't have a car seat, there are a limited number of car seats available. We ask for a \$20 donation. You must bring your child, car seat and vehicle to the appointment.

Please bring the User's Manuals for both the vehicle and car seat.
