Fire District and Sheriff Office to Announce New Addition to Hurricane Responses

St. Lucie County – On Wednesday, May 17, 2017 the Fire District in conjunction with the Sheriff's Office will announce a new partnership for responding and transporting patients during severe weather events.

Using military surplus, heavy-duty vehicles, the Sheriff's Office will provide personnel the safe means necessary to perform life-saving services during adverse weather conditions that restrict the use of a traditional rescue truck.

Media are asked to arrive no later than 10:45 am and check in with Brenda Stokes (Fire District) or Bryan Beaty (Sheriff's Office). Opportunities to video the vehicle as well as interview the Fire Chief and the Sheriff will be available. The event will take place at the Fire District's Administrative Complex at 5160 NW Milner Dr.
