### **Flight Team Participates in Water Survival Training**

**St. Lucie County** – On November 13th, 14th, and 15th; the St. Lucie County Air Rescue Flight Team will participate in a water egress training at Indian River State College (IRSC). This training prepares the flight team with survival techniques in the event of a water landing emergency.

The training will take place in the swimming pool at the IRSC main campus in Fort Pierce. Flight members will be required to wear their flight suits to simulate a real water event where they will ascend from the bottom of the pool with a Personal Flotation Device.

The training rotations will be as follows:

Monday, November 13th; 8:00am-11:30am and 12:00noon-3:30pm

Tuesday, November 14th; 8:00am-11:30am and 12:00noon-3:30pm

Wednesday, November 15th; 8:00am-11:30am and 12:00noon-3:30pm

This is a 3.5 hour training, provided six times over. Please contact Brenda Stokes to make arrangements if you would like to visit the training location.
