Clanton, Casson Honored by St. Lucie County Fire District

Employee and Firefighter of the Quarter Honored at Fire Board Meeting

St. Lucie County, FL – Lt. Lewis Clanton and Joey Casson were named Firefighter of the Quarter and Civilian Employee of the Quarter by the St. Lucie Fire District. The two were honored at a recent Fire Board Meeting.

Lt. Clanton joined the SLCFD in 1989. He is currently stationed at Fire Station #3 on Ravenswood in Port St. Lucie. He serves on the Operations Committee and is team leader for B-shift with the Rescue Boat.

“He is highly motivated and extremely professional, which he instills into the members of his crew,” said Fire Chief Ron Parrish.

Chief Parrish noted that motivation resulted in the Fire Station contributing 5,435 pounds of food at the last One Day to Give food drive.
